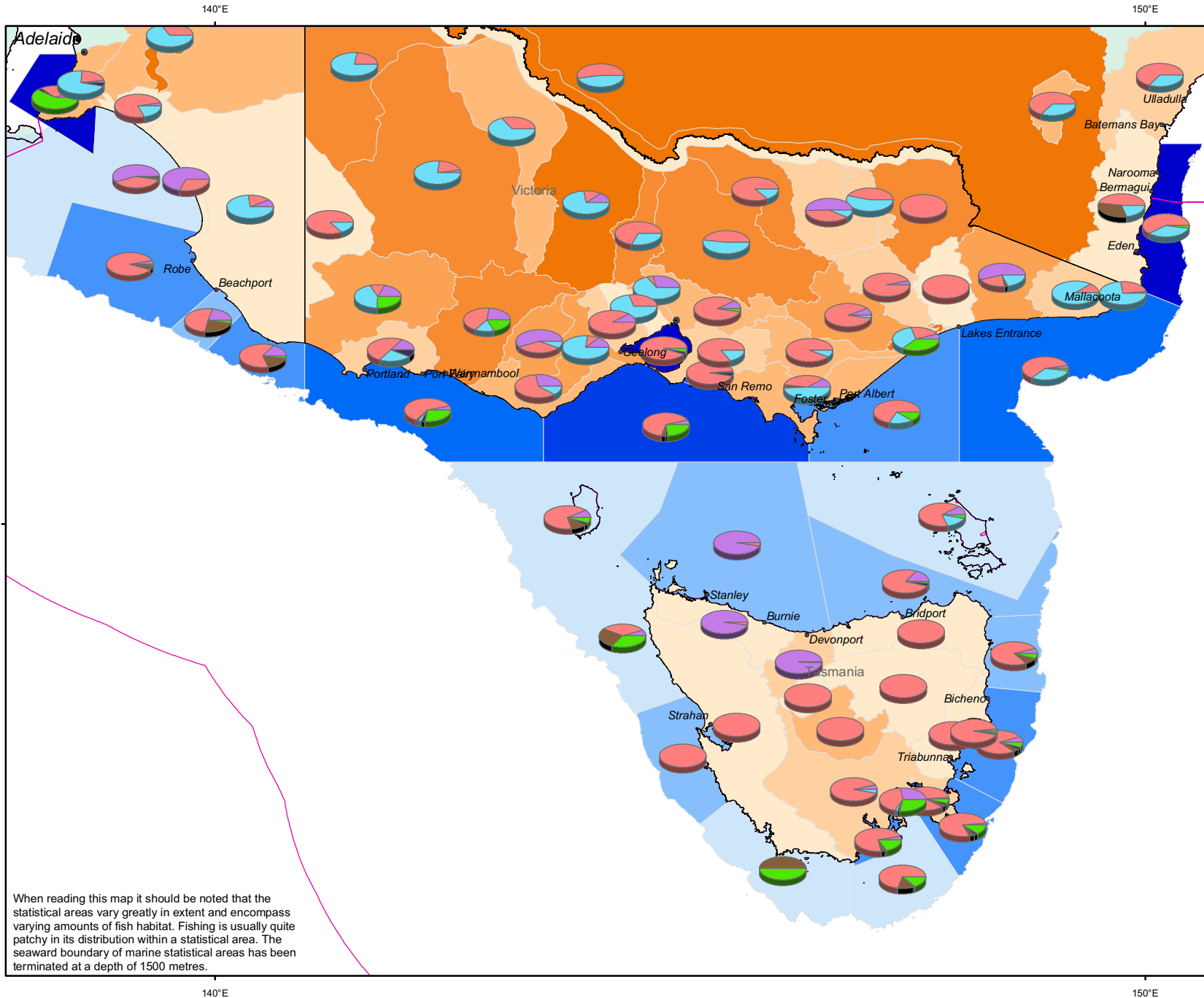


Recreational Fishing Catch - South Eastern Region
